

At Qualsys, we are actively monitoring and implementing all official guidance to protect the health, safety and wellbeing of all people and will continue to do so. To reassure you, there are currently no reports of coronavirus among any of our people.

Health and Hygiene

At Qualsys we take the health and wellbeing of our staff very seriously. Flexible working is standard practice at Qualsys, and staff members have been working from home since 17th March, onwards and until further notice.

We have requested that all staff follow the recommended advice as per the latest Government announcements.

Anyone who has travelled to an affected area, or who has been in close contact with an infected person, are asked to self-isolate for 14 days.

Hand sanitizers have been made available throughout the office for those who do need to go in.

Business Travel

Qualsys have requested that staff continue to work from home and continues to ban all business travel unless it is absolutely essential. This will remain under review, in-line with the Government guidance and we will be in constant liaison with our customers.

Risk Assessment

Although Working from Home continues to be our policy, we appreciate that there are some circumstances that may require a visit to the office. The Health and Safety Risk Assessment has been reviewed and updated and is available on our website.

Some of the activities that we have undertaken to help ensure the health and well-being of our staff and visitors (when that time may come) visiting the office include, but are not limited to; rotas, limiting the numbers of staff allowed in at any one time to ensure social distancing, face masks, sanitisers and information posters.
